Our designs will match the style of the original windows with slim timber sections, without compromising performance.




Key Features

- Traditionally proportioned timber sections to replicate original window details
- Excellent thermal and weather performance
- Fully gasket sealed for greater weather resistance
- Stainless steel hardware, hinges, locks and fixings
- Friction hinge (egress optional) or traditional butt hinge
- Multipoint locking securing the window shut at several points along the length of the frame









Security Claw

Fitted as an option on to the hinge side of the sash, these claws provide additional strength against intruder attack and offer excellent security performance.



Multipoint Locking

Multipoint locking fitted as standard - securing the window shut at several points along the length of the frame. Having multiple fixing points also helps with timber stability and in turn product life.



Internal Beading

Offering an enhanced security glazing system with all sashes glazed from the inside. Internal beading increases product performance and life expectancy. The sashes are also drained and ventilated for greater life expectancy.



Trickle Vents

Trickle vents are concealed into the frame of the window with an external timber canopy to conceal them on the outside.

Colour matching is available.

A large choice of hardware in contemporary or traditional design. Hardware available in a large range of finishes




Astragal Bars






Horizontal Section B-B

Heritage Flush





High Performance Flush




Vertical Section A-A

Heritage Flush












High Performance Flush










Vertical Section C-C
